YOUR MENTOR/TEACHER

WORKS WITH:

- Mentor meetings
- Three-way conversations (mentor–parent–student)
- Observations
- Individual support for things like fear of failure, executive functioning skills, grief/loss
- Protocols*, such as anti-bullying and safety reporting
- Educational sessions (information lessons)
- Language support by an NT2 (Dutch as a second language) teacher
- Education focused on life skills (based on the IB Learner Profile)

FOCUSES ON:

- Planning and organizing
- Learning how to learn
- Setting learning goals
- Giving and receiving feedback
- Social interaction
- Well-being and a positive classroom atmosphere
- Study coaching (Who am I? What do I want? What am I good at?)
